Public Meeting:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) has scheduled a Public Information Meeting for three (3) proposed bridge repairs in Darlington County. They are as follows: SC 41 over Reedy Creek, US 401 over Sparrow Creek, and SC 34 over Black Creek. This meeting will be held on Thursday, August 25, 2022, from 5pm-7pm at the Darlington Recreation Department located at 300 Sanders Street, Darlington, SC 29532. This meeting will have a drop-in style format with project displays available for viewing. Interested persons may attend this informal meeting at any time between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., during which SCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions. Formal, verbal comments will not be taken after the presentation.

Project Overview/Purpose:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) proposes to repair five load restricted primary bridges in SCDOT District 5 area. Three of which are located in Darlington County. The purpose of this project is to reduce the number of load restricted bridges by performing comprehensive and cost effective bridge repairs identified at SC 41 over Reedy Creek, US 401 over Sparrow Creek, SC 34 over Black Creek.
