## Public Information Meeting

### **Meeting:**

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) has scheduled a Public Information Meeting. This meeting will be held on Thursday, October 13, 2022, from 5-7 PM at the Myrtle Beach Train Depot, 851 Broadway Street, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577. This meeting is concerning safety improvements to Mr. Joe White Avenue and 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue North in Horry County, South Carolina. The meeting will be a drop-in format and will have displays for viewing. Citizens will also have the opportunity to provide written comments.
