



SCDOT Requests Public Comment on the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program to Include the Preliminary Engineering, Right of Way and Construction Phases to Twelve (12) Closed Bridges Located within Various Counties of the State

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests comments from the public on twelve closed bridge projects in ten counties to be included in the 2021-2027 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The public has the opportunity to comment on the action to amend the STIP to include the preliminary engineering, right of way and construction phases of work. SCDOT will receive public comment for a 21-day period from **August 12, 2022** through **September 1, 2022**.

SCDOT certifies that these projects were selected in consideration of established priorities as required by federal laws or regulations and in accordance with SC Code of Laws Section 57-1-370 (Act 114) and the SCDOT's 10 Year Plan.

A summary of substantive comments will be available to the Commission. Pending no substantive comments, these projects will be added to a subsequent STIP version.
