



SCDOT Requests Public Comment on a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment to Include Preliminary Engineering and Construction Phases for the I-95 Corridor Improvements from MM 21 to MM 33.9 (Exit 33) Project

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests comments from the public on the I-95 Corridor Improvements from MM 21 – MM 33.9 (Exit 33) Project in Jasper County. The SCDOT Commission approved a public comment opportunity for the proposed corridor improvement project during its July 21, 2022 meeting.

The public has the opportunity to comment on the action to amend the STIP to include the preliminary engineering and construction phases of work. SCDOT will accept public comments for a 21-day period from **July 22, 2022** through **August 11, 2022**.

This Project will improve capacity, mobility, and operations along the 12 mile corridor of I-95 and address operational deficiencies for the interchanges and bridges within the study corridor.

A summary of substantive comments will be made available to the Commission. Pending consideration of public comments, the approval of the phases of work will be added to a subsequent version of STIP.
