



SCDOT Requests Public Comment on the Proposed 2021-22 Pavement Improvement Program

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests comments from the public on the proposed 2021-22 Pavement Improvement Program. The public has the opportunity to comment on the recommended ranked pavement improvement project lists for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of the Primary route system, Farm-to-Market Secondary system, and Neighborhood streets for the state fiscal year 2021-2022.

The Transportation Commission approved, during its May 20, 2021 meeting, a public comment period to include the proposed 2021-2022 Pavement Improvement Program in the 2017-2022 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (**STIP**). SCDOT will receive public comment for a 21-day period from [May 24, 2021](#) through [June 16, 2021](#).

The projects recommended for the proposed 2021-2022 Pavement Improvement Program were selected utilizing ranking processes that: are based on objective and quantifiable road condition factors; comply with the Ten-Year Plan for rebuilding South Carolina's roads; and support the performance targets established in the Commission-approved Transportation Asset Management Plan (TAMP). The project selection process also ensures a county-by-county distribution of paving funds so that roads in every county of the state in greatest need of repair are repaved.

The projects included on the 2021-22 Pavement Improvement Program list will account for **997** new miles of proposed paving work. The funding allocation necessary to complete this work is estimated at **\$472M**.

Upon completion of the 21-day public comment period, any substantive comments will be provided to the Commission. Barring any substantive comments, the projects will be incorporated in the **STIP**.
