#### **Question:**

The following question was presented to SCDOT concerning Solicitation Number S-182-16, CE&I Services for the SC51 Pamplico Highway Widening Projects Section 1-4:

On Page 6 under Item #2 and on page 6 under Item #4 the RFQ states “Legal names (first, middle, and last).” Will a middle initial suffice for each name or do you require the full middle names?

#### **SCDOT Response:**

The South Carolina General Assembly Legislative Audit Council (LAC) Report dated April 2016, “A Review of the S.C. Department of Transportation” contained the recommendation: “The S.C. Department of Transportation should revise its Notice to All Consulting Firms to require that the names of individuals who will work on the project be submitted as the individual’s formal name, including the full first, middle, and last name and maiden name, if appropriate.”

SCDOT has incorporated the recommendation listed above into the requirements for future Request for Proposal submittals. Therefore middle initials will not suffice. The full first, middle and last names are required.
