SCDOT Operations Mode: Recovery

Statewide Summary – There are 17 road closures on primary and secondary routes due to damage or flooding throughout the affected area. Please find a current road closure report attached below.

SCDOT is focused on recovery efforts as a result of the damage caused by Hurricane Florence. Crews and contractors continue to make repairs to damaged roadways. Please find a report on the current status of the repair efforts attached below.

To date, 15,795 cubic yards of structural debris associated with flooding from Hurricane Florence have been removed from SCDOT right of way.

In areas affected by flooding, motorists are urged to obey all road closures. Never move or drive around barricades. Remember: It is NEVER safe to drive or walk into flood waters. Turn around, don't drown!

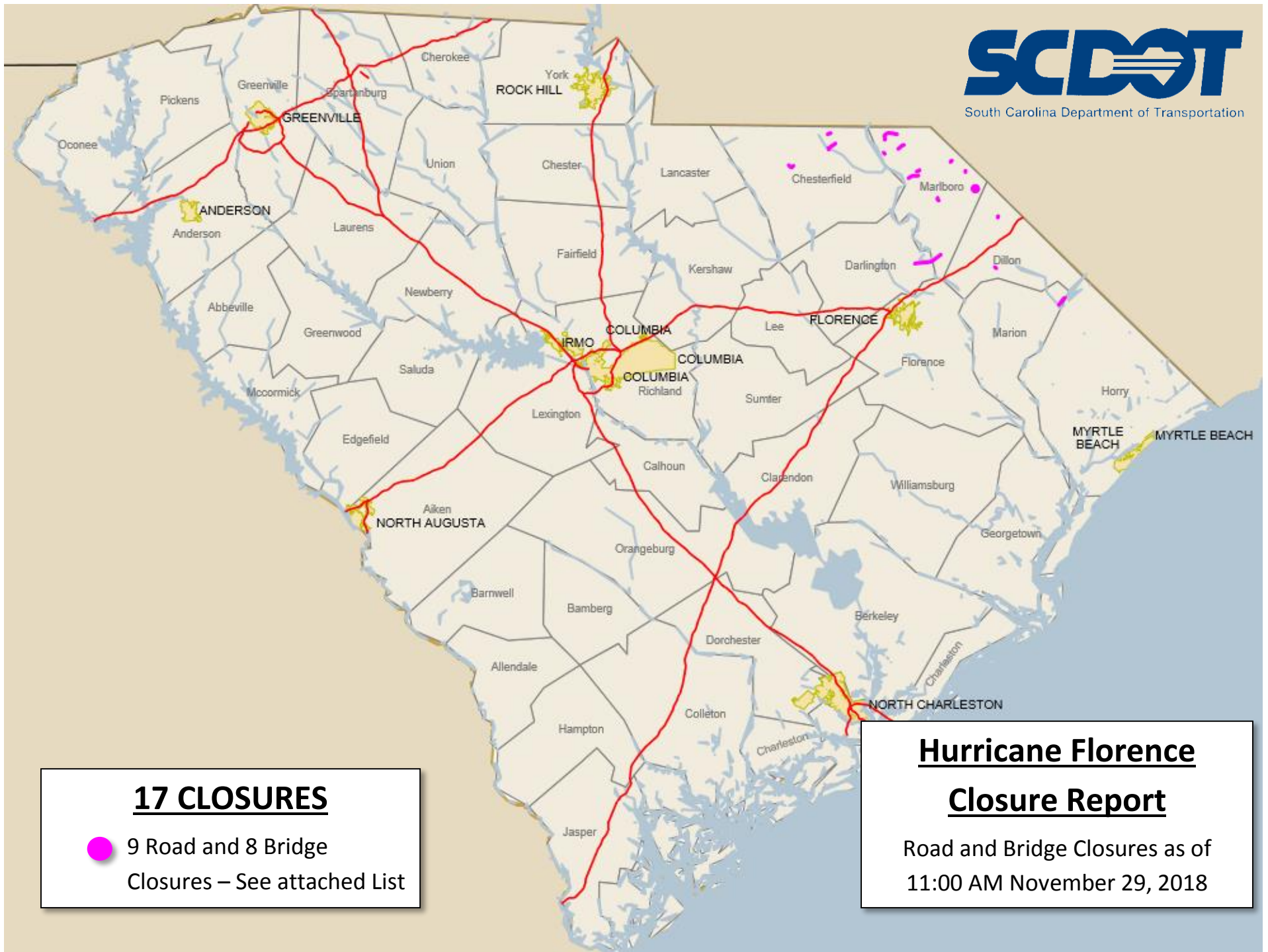
