QUALIFIED PRODUCT POLICY FOR RIGHT OF WAY MARKERS

General:

The purpose of this policy is to outline procedures by which Right-of-Way Marker manufacturers will be qualified *for use in SCDOT work.*

Manufacturers Facility Inspection:

All prospective manufacturers of Right-of-Way Markers shall receive an initial inspection by the Office of Materials and Research personnel. Follow-up inspections will be performed as deemed necessary to assure compliance with policy and product specifications. The following will be accomplished during the inspection:

- Concrete complies with the required mix design and that materials are from approved sources.
- Dimensions of the item will be cast to plan requirements within acceptable tolerances.
- Reinforcing steel shall be as specified on plans.
- The manufacturer's quality control personnel shall have a satisfactory plan to control the casting operation to produce items in conformance with plans.

To Qualify a Manufacturer to Supply Right-of-Way Markers:

Manufacturers of Right-of-Way Markers will be qualified and listed on Qualified Product List 16 if the above requirements are met and the Right-of-Way Markers will be used in SCDOT work.
