




City of Abbeville Downtown Sidewalk Improvements

The South Carolina Department of Transportation and the City of Abbeville are proposing to replace aging sidewalks and install lighting along East Pickens Street (L-944) in downtown Abbeville. The purpose of the project is to provide ADA-compliant sidewalks, pedestrian lighting, and beautification improvements through this area of downtown Abbeville.

What will happen during construction?

SCDOT proposes to maintain automobile traffic during construction; however, sidewalks may be temporarily unavailable.



Project Funding:

The proposed project is being funded through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), a federally-funded grant program for pedestrian, bicycle, and streetscape improvements. Eligible project sponsors typically include local governments or school districts. Projects are awarded through a competitive application process.

Project Schedule:

Preliminary Engineering: UNDERWAY Right-of-Way Acquisition: Summer 2022 Construction: Summer 2023 to early 2024
