

SC 260 over Second Water-Lake Marion in Clarendon County



Public Information Meeting:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) welcomes you to this Public Information Meeting. We appreciate your attendance at this meeting and encourage your feedback. The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public an opportunity to review and discuss the proposed bridge deck repair.

What is the project?

SCDOT proposes to repair the bridge located on SC 260 over Second Water-Lake Marion in Clarendon County. Portions of the existing bridge have deteriorated to the point that repairs are necessary. The proposed repairs will improve mobility in the region and extend the service life of the bridge.



How much will this cost?

- This bridge repair will cost approx. **\$695K** to construct.

How is this project funded?

Using both state and federal funds from the Statewide Bridge Preservation program identified in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

What is the Schedule?

- Bridge Construction is set to begin during the **Summer of 2023**.
- Closure will not exceed **45 calendar days**.

What will happen during repairs/construction?

SCDOT proposes to close SC 260 at the bridge location during construction. SCDOT plans on utilizing Kenwood Road, Shaw Road, and Durant Lane for the detour route as the bridge is being repaired. The net detour length is 8.30 miles. SCDOT expects to close the road for 45 days while the repairs are underway.
