

# S-234(Racetrack Rd.) Bridge Replacement over

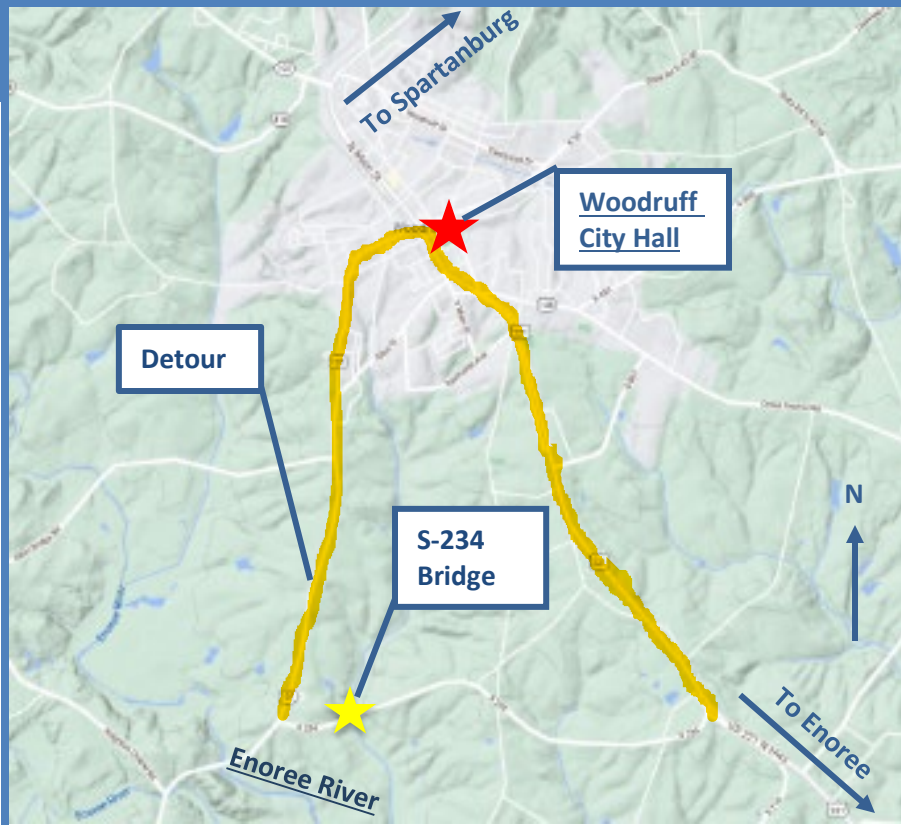
## Dildine Creek in Spartanburg County

### Public Information Meeting:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) welcomes you to this Public Information Meeting. We appreciate your attendance at this meeting and encourage your feedback. The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public an opportunity to review and discuss the proposed bridge replacement.

### What is the project?

SCDOT proposes to replace the existing bridge along S-234 (Racetrack Rd) over Dildine Creek in Spartanburg County. The existing bridge is deteriorated to the point that continuing to perform on-going repairs is no longer practical. SCDOT will monitor the existing bridge from now until construction of the new bridge begins. The project is part of SCDOT's Strategic Plan to greatly reduce the number of closed and load restricted bridges in the State of South Carolina.



### How much will this cost?

Total Cost: Approx. \$2 Million to construct.

- \$1.3 Million for Bridge Construction
- \$200,000 for Engineering & Inspection
- \$430,000 for Road Construction

### How is this project funded?

Using both state and federal funds from the Off-System Bridge Replacement Program identified in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

### What is the Schedule?

- Preliminary Engineering: Currently underway
- Right of Way Acquisition: Summer 2021
- Construction: Summer 2022

### What will happen during construction?

SCDOT proposes to close S-234 (Racetrack Rd) during construction. SCDOT plans on utilizing U.S. Route 221 (Laurens Road/S. Main Street) and SC Highway 101 (W. Georgia Street/W. Georgia Road) for the detour route as shown in the map above. SCDOT expects to close the road for 9 to 12 months while the existing bridge is demolished and the new bridge is constructed.

Title VI compliance: SCDOT complies with all requirements set forth by Federal regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation under the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended.
