► PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

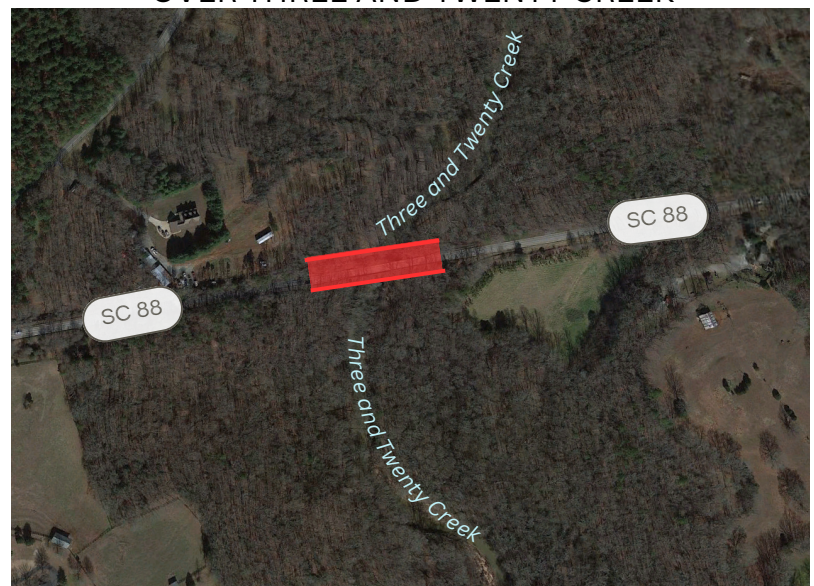

► PROJECT OVERVIEW

SCDOT proposes bridge repair, rehabilitation, and preservation activities for several statewide bridge maintenance projects. The purpose of this project is to reduce the number of load restricted bridges by performing comprehensive and cost effective bridge repairs. These repairs are part of SCDOT's Statewide Closed and Load Restricted Bridge Repair Program. The proposed repairs will improve mobility in the region and extend the service life of the bridges.

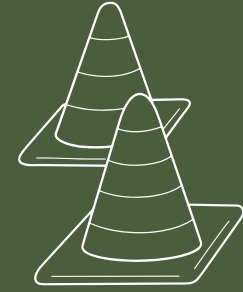

Title VI Compliance: SCDOT complies with all requirements set forth by Federal regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended.
